Joseph Bloggs has been working a nurse since 1985. During his career he has worked in many specialties and geographic locations.

The last five years has seen Joseph move into the academic sector where he has been able to bring his experience and knowledge as a hospital director of nursing education. He is deputy head of school and leads a team of academic experts working in research and education of students.

Despite working at Western University in a full-time capacity, Joseph has continued to be a driving force as an advocate for the professions through his membership on various State and national committees relevant to the education of nurses and midwives.

He is professionally affiliated with the Australian College of Nursing, the International College of Nursing and was recently inducted as a Fellow to

Joseph is internationally acknowledged as a leader in the area of nurse education and is often invited to conferences as a keynote speaker to present on his widely published works as a nurse researcher and educator.

One of his most well-known impacts on the nursing profession was his development of the XYZ Scale for preceptors to use when guiding and orientating new staff and students to a unit. The development of the XYZ Scale took Joseph five years of trial and research before it was accepted, and today it is widely used as a standard measure across Australian, New Zealand and Canadian universities. Joseph was acknowledged for his commitment to this process when he was awarded WA Nurse Citizen of the Year.

Throughout his career, Joseph has been nominated for many other awards of recognition. Recently he was nominated by the Chancellor of Western University for Australian of the Year for his service to the university, its staff, students, the nursing profession and the wider community.

As a student nurse fifteen years ago I was lucky enough to be working on a surgical ward where Joseph was the Staff Development Nurse. I am sure that his influence on me and my career as a nurse during those short weeks of clinical practice led me to the role I hold today.

His ability to impart his knowledge to me as a student set me up to continue to seek learning opportunities and inspire me to teach others.

After graduating from university and completing my graduate years, I headed back to university to gain postgraduate qualifications in my area of specialty. This quickly led me to feel brave enough to put my hand up for a staff development role. I have been working in nurse education since.

When I applied to Western University as a lecturer three years ago I was delighted to learn that my supervisor would again be Joseph. I am pleased to say that Joseph still teaches me new things each time we meet.
